UPDATE ON CHURCH OPENING

Following the latest announcement from the government we are going to be able to gather in church for Mass from 10th May.
 As before, there are certain conditions in place:

- MAXIMUM of 50 people
- Social distancing
- Sanitising hands on entry and exit
- Wearing face masks while inside
- Church doors will also need to be left open to provide the necessary ventilation.

Up to 50 people will be allowed to attend funerals and wedding services in church. However, the government are advising that other religious ceremonies, especially those that could involve gatherings before/afterwards like Communion and Confirmations, do not take place at this time. The resumption of the celebration of Baptisms remains under close review.
