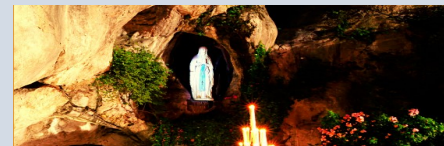
**It is important for the local faith community to gather, to pray, to worship together, but also to do so safely.**
