# **Christmas Mass Schedule & Booking**

Sadly still in these difficult times, once again this Christmas, we find we can not welcome everyone with open arms. We are restricted to 50% of capacity maximum, while still maintaining social distancing. This really limits our numbers.

Once again we will rely on everyone's patience and generosity of spirit. Despite our stretched resources we will put on extra Masses, in our relatively small churches. We will, thankfully for this Christmas, be able to stream most of our Christmas Masses live into the homes of family and loved ones, direct now from our churches.

Our Christmas Eve Masses are aimed at accommodating as many <u>families</u> as we can, and so must be booked in advance. We will be open for booking (<u>online only</u>) <u>from 11:00am on Tuesday 14th December</u>. Places will be allocated automatically on a first come, first served basis until the capacity for each local church is reached.

Those with no internet access or online booking knowhow are asked to enlist the help of family or friends. Those who do not succeed getting a family booking, are invited to please try to join with us online at home.

Christmas Day Masses will also be subject to the same big restrictions. Access for these will <u>not</u> be by pre-booking, but will be open to all on the day <u>on a first come</u>, <u>first served basis until the max capacity for each church is reached</u>. With this in mind we again ask everyone who can to please consider joining with us online at home.
